

South Punjab in Urgent Need

South Punjab is facing an alarming crisis: child malnutrition rates have crossed **40%** among children under five, leaving thousands at risk of stunting, illness, and life long health challenges.

In response, **Trust for Malnutrition & Stunted Growth (TMSG)**, in collaboration with **Allah Walay Trust (AWT)**, has launched a **Child Feeding Program** across **Rajanpur, Layyah, Dera Ghazi Khan, and Muzaffargarh**.

Key Highlights:

- **11 private** pediatric clinics established as treatment centers.
- Trained pediatricians provide free nutritional counseling and distribute Ready-to-Use **Therapeutic Food (RUTF)**.
- **Hundreds of children** already registered and receiving treatment.
- Plans underway to expand by **45 more clinics** to cover the overwhelming burden of malnutrition in the region.

Dr. Ghulam Subhani Tabassum practices at Herman Day Care Medical Center, Fazilpur, District Rajanpur, located on Indus Highway opposite the NADRA Office. He is known for his dedicated service to the local community, providing essential healthcare with commitment and compassion at children hospital Multan as well.



- Transportation facilitated by **Al-Khair UK**.
- Additional relief and essential supplies included in the containers.

In Gaza, where war has destroyed homes and left families without kitchens or resources to cook, RUTF is vital. Each sachet provides ready-to-eat, lifesaving nutrition offering immediate strength and restoring hope to children caught between hunger and survival.

We are proud to announce the declaration of **National Hospital Faisalabad** as a **Model Malnutrition Center** through the establishment of the **Iftikhar Ahmad Malnutrition Center**.

With the visionary leadership of **Chairman Zulfiqar Shafi** and the dedicated efforts of **Dr. Binish Sawar & Dr. Mansoor Ahmed**, over 5,000 children have already been **rescued from malnutrition**. This model sets the standard for other healthcare institutions across Pakistan.

How You Can Help Support a Child, Save a Life

“And whoever saves one life – it is as if he had saved all of mankind.” — Quran 5:32

You can directly save lives by supporting the treatment of malnourished children:

Moderate Acute Malnutrition (MAM)

For children with Moderate Acute Malnutrition, the treatment usually takes about 4 to 6 weeks, with a total cost per child of PKR 2,072 – 3,108 (USD \$10 – \$15).

Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM)

For children suffering from Severe Acute Malnutrition, the treatment duration typically ranges from 8 to 12 weeks, with a total cost per child of PKR 8,288 – 12,432 (USD \$30 – \$45).
